

Motions notified at the point of sending to print.

Motion 1

At the last AGM, members tasked the committee with proposing how the club should include joint members. After several discussions, the committee has recognised the value of joint members to the life and enjoyment of the club and the contribution of joint members to all parts of the committee and organising commitments.

We noted that joint members are already included in club rules so no rule change is required but we do need to agree the definition of what a joint member is.

The Club Committee therefore proposes the following options for decision.

1. That joint members be defined as a named person who is a partner of a full member, living at the same address and sharing any information sent by the club.
2. Joint members will have the same vote as a full member whenever a vote is called.
3. Joint members will receive the same benefits and discounts as a full member of the club.
4. Joint members will be able to bring their own vehicle to our events, if they have one, and will be judged for prizes alongside full members (each member can already have 2 show passes)
5. Joint members' vehicles will be counted towards 'best attendance' trophies.
6. The subscription for a full member is to be £18 per year
7. The subscription for Joint membership (member and partner) to be £20 per year
8. This proposal is effective from a) 1st January 2019
b) 1st January 2020.

NB: the committee proposes to move the motion as a whole to start with, then discuss and vote for the options one by one to allow as open a decision making process as we can.

Under the rules, other motions can be presented to the AGM provided that they are given to the Chairperson before the meeting starts. Amendments can be put forward before or during discussion and voted on accordingly.

(Rule 21 states that the AGM is to decide on business notified to the Chairperson before the start of the meeting. Any proposals arising during the meeting will be taken if a majority of members present agree to that happening.)
